THE DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE DEPENDENTS SCHOOLS (DoDDS)

DoDDS was established in 1946 to provide quality education from kindergarten through grade 12 for the children of American military and Department of Defense personnel stationed overseas. As it presently exists, DoDDS has a student population of over 71,100 students in 153 schools located in 13 countries. Students graduating from DoDDS have spent an average of three years studying, learning and experiencing a culture other than their own.

SEOUL AMERICAN HIGH SCHOOL 1958-2006

DESCRIPTION:

Located on Yongsan Army Garrison in downtown Seoul, Korea, Seoul American High School serves students in grades 9-12. Approximately 670 dependents of the US Army, Navy, Marine, Air Force and Civilian Personnel assigned to the greater Seoul area attend this federal public school.

ACCREDITATION:

North Central Association of Colleges and Schools (NCA) provides public school certification. SAHS received its first accreditation certificate in SY 1958-1959 and has been fully accredited each year since. The most recent visit by an NCA accreditation team was completed in April 2004.

FACULTY:

There are 45.5 classroom teachers, 3 guidance counselors, 3.5 special education teachers, 1 school psychologist, 1 education technology teacher, 1.5 nurse, & 1 information specialist. More than half of the geographically diverse faculty have a Master's degree or higher.

COLLEGE ADMISSIONS:

Approximately 83% of the recent graduates entered 4 year institutions of higher learning and 11% entered 2 year institutions of higher learning in the United States.

SCHOOL YEAR:

A thirty-eight week school year divided into two semesters with two 9-week grading periods per semester.
